WHEREAS, based on her observations of children and the manner by which

WHEREAS, a system of education for children from birth through the age of

18, the Montessori program uses materials, techniques and observations that support the students' natural development, encourage their learning, independence and self-confidence, while advancing the principles of peace through responsible

citizenship; and

WHEREAS, the Montessori method includes developmental teaching, one-to-

one lessons and the promotion of respect among the children and

peace to humankind; and

WHEREAS, Montessori schools are a valuable and thriving asset to education

in the state of Louisiana.
